Curriculum Overview for Parents



Maths

- Numbers to 100: counting to 100, finding tens and ones, comparing numbers and making number patterns.
- Grouping and sharing small quantities and understand: multiplication and division; doubling numbers and quantities; and finding simple fractions of objects, numbers and quantities. Students will make connections between arrays, number patterns, and counting in twos, fives and tens.
- Fractions: Making halves, quarters and sharing and grouping.
- Understand the importance of counting, using money for role playing activities.
- The students will look at telling time to the hour and to the half hour. They will learn to use next, before and after. Estimating duration of time, compare time and how to use a calendar.
- Students be looking at comparing and volume and capacity, finding volume and capacity and describing volume using half and a quarter.

Mandarin
